DESIGN CONCEPT

All activities such as sitting, eating, cooking and sleeping had to be put together in close proximity for walking convenience but without visual barriers except for the sleeping - or the bed room. The upper level had to be reached without climbing a full floor height. The out door sit out space had to be kept away from direct contact with the road in the front.

The design of this house immerged out of these requirements.

A hillock as a back drop called for a sloping roof and the low eves level, within reach, brought the desired intimacy with the abode.



MATERIALS USED

: Load bearing structure with brick walls
RCC sloping roof

Polished kotah flooring with marble masaic in situ strips.

Polished teak wood window frames and shutters with glazing.

reak wood flush doors.

Colour glazed tile flooring in bathroom with vitran glazed tiles to dado

Plaster of paris on internal surfaces of walls with plastic imulssion paint.

Sand face cement plaster on external surfacewith cement paint.

Baroda green marble with stainless steel sink in kitchen counter.

concealed wiring and plumbing.
